I understand that a lawyer has been trained in the rules of law and that if I conduct my own defense I may not understand the rules used in court. I understand that there may be possible defenses that a lawyer may know to raise, such as defects in the citations or accusation, misidentification, alibi or a reliance on the presumption of innocence. I understand that if I proceed without a lawyer, I may encounter situations in which I may wish to call witnesses to testify and to question witnesses, and that I may not know how to do this properly. I understand that if I have a jury trial there may be legal and strategy issues involved in selecting jurors. I understand that issues must be properly preserved in court records in order to form the basis for any appeal that I may wish to make at the conclusion of this proceeding. I understand that the decision to testify in a criminal case must be made by me and that any right to a jury trial can be waived only by me. I know and understand these dangers of proceeding to trial without a lawyer.
